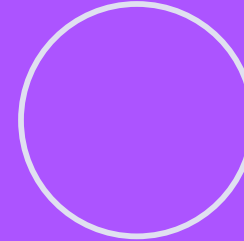
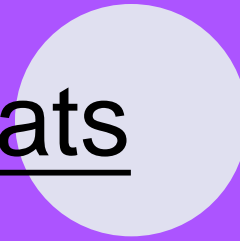


## Appearance

- They are dark brown and light grey mainly but they can come in different colours to. they have quite big ears and four legs. They are also very timid.



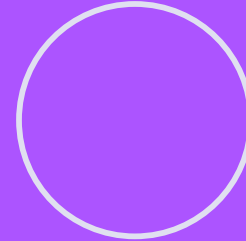
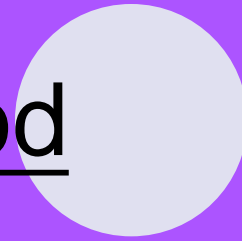

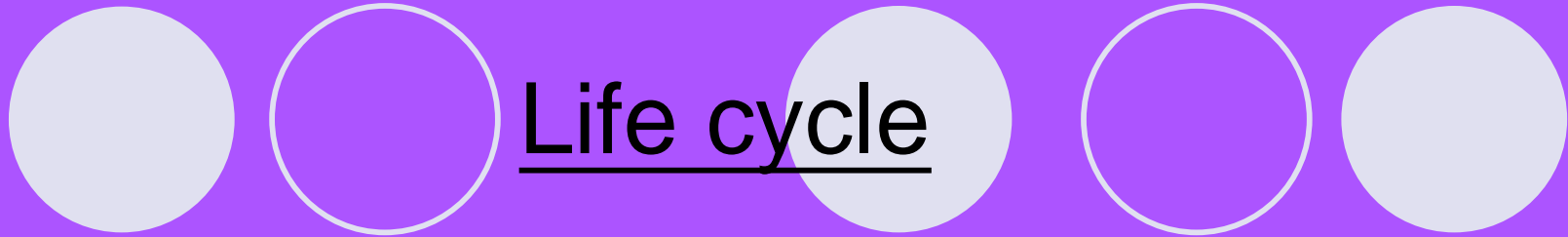
- They live in burrows under ground . A burrow is a hole in the ground that an animal has dug to live in.

 Wild rabbits eat grass and plants that are found in fields and many other places.

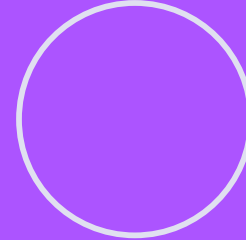


- When a baby is born it is born alive .just before the mother makes a nest out of leaves and its own fur .Babies are called kittens or bunnies.
